SIX SHORT RULES FOR NEW CHRISTIANS

- 1) Never neglect private daily prayer, and when you pray, remember that God is present, and that He hears your prayers (Hebrews 11:6)
- 2) Never neglect daily private Bible Reading: and when you read remember that God is speaking to you, and that you are to believe and act upon what He says: I believe all backsliding begins with the neglect of these two rules. (2 Timothy 2:15)
- 3) Never let a day pass without trying to do something for Jesus. Every night reflect on what Jesus has done for you and then ask yourself, "What am I doing for Him?" (Matthew 5:13-16)
- 4) If you are in doubt as to a thing being right or wrong, go to your room and kneel down and ask God's blessing on it (Colossians 3:17) If you cannot do this it is wrong (Romans 16:19)
- 5) Never take your Christianity from Christians, or argue that because such and such people do so and so, therefore you may (2 Corinthians 10:12) You are to ask yourself "How would Christ act in my place?" and strive to follow Him.
- 6) Never believe what you feel, if it contradicts God's Word. Ask yourself, "Can what I feel be true if God's Word is true?" and if BOTH cannot be true, believe God and make your own heart the liar (1 John 1:10; 5:10-11).
