Thanks you for participating in our sale! Here are a few guidelines and tips to help you get organized for the event.

What items are acceptable for the sale?

ONLY Spring and Summer items may be sold our Spring Sale including:

- *Good quality, freshly laundered children's clothing, sizes 0-12 years
- *Maternity Wear
- *Outer Wear and seasonal wear (Light Jackets, Swimwear, Sandals...)
- ***Friendly** Dress Up clothes
- *Indoor Toys and Seasonal Outdoor Toys
- *Books, Games, Puzzles
- *Bikes, scooters
- *Cribs, Strollers, Car Seats, Bouncy Chairs, Swings, etc...
(all car seats and cribs **MUST** meet current regulations!!!)

What Items WILL NOT be acceptable for the sale?

- *Fall and Winter items (watch for our Fall Sale!)
- *Stuffed Animals
- *Broken or Dirty items or items that have pieces missing

How do I prepare myself for the sale?

- *Wash items within 2 weeks of sale
- *Price items prior to sale. May be priced separately or prepackage small or multiple items (eg: baby socks, sleepers, small toys...)
- *Size and Price of item to be written on masking tape or sticker labels
- *Ensure clothes have no stains and are in good repair
- *Make sure all toys are in working order with batteries
- *Supply own rack and hangers if wanting to hang items
- *Only use Rubbermaid bins (or similar style) if you want to place multiple items of the same price together. The bins must be in good condition
NO CARDBOARD BOXES PLEASE
- *Label bins as to size and price per item with a printed sign
- *Supply your own cash float
- *Supply plastic bags for buyers (can be grocery bags)

We reserve the right to ask you to remove items from the sale that we deem are not appropriate.

How do I know where my table will be?

You will be able to pick your table from an available map (online or in the office).

We will do our best to have the tables in the same location as on the map

We do reserve the right to modify this table arrangement based on how many tables sold

How do I set up my table?

All clothing, toys, books, and baby items will be at your individual tables. You will be designated **4 feet** on one side of the table for clothing rack and other items (This will be marked out). You may place things under your table but they cannot extend farther than 1 foot from your table. We will be strict about abiding by these guidelines as we have had fire code issues!

If you bring plastic totes for items, please make sure they are in good repair. This will help us to keep our Clothing Sale more professional. Displaying your items well shows the buyer that you take good care of them.

Display ideas from past vendors:

- * Put outfits together either in Ziploc bags (price on the outside) or hang them together
- * Place clothing of the same size together (either on table or on clothing rack).
- * If you use totes for items, it is easier that they all be the **same** thing (i.e pants) with a general price marked on the outside. Most shoppers won't spend the time to dig through a bin of multiple items (i.e. shirts, pants, hats, etc)
- * If you have shelves or rods to use to maximize your space- use it! The better displayed your items are, the better they sell. I.e.: small bookshelves can be used to display shoes, steel rods can be hung from front of table with industrial clamps to add clothing rods, etc.
- * You'll be surprised at how much you actually have. That table will fill up once your start displaying clothes.
- * Remember, you can always book more than 1 table if you have an abundance of items. We can push 2 tables together for you.

Buyers will purchase ALL items **DIRECTLY FROM YOU**. Please make sure you have a cash float for this.

What happens after the sale?

It is your responsibility to pack up your remaining items.
