A satellite campus of SGAC, the Calahoo congregation meets:


- Sundays at 10am for our family worship service

At SGAC, Kids are wanted! We believe that teaching kids about Jesus, faith and Biblical values are critical to prepare them for a purposeful and fulfilling life. We want them to know they are loved, accepted and belong here as we develop relationships, teach and train them in serving. We want to partner with parents to help raise our kids in the fear and love of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ.

Weekend Services offer Discovery Island:

All children check in at the foyer computers before the service - each parent will receive a tag with which to retrieve your child at the end of each service.

- **Nursery:** Infants to 2 year old toddlers can be dropped off for supervision and parents will receive a pager to alert them if their child needs their attention.


