to do with saying sorry. Rather, it is a discipline in which you seek to provide the rational basis for your beliefs. In short, why do we believe what we believe? As I head into my first full ministry year at SGAC, I hope to "whet the intellectual appetite" of the SGAC family as we train together in seeing the whole world through the lens of a Christian worldview.

GAC Reads Book Club

## Refugee Sponsorship

Exciting news from the refugee team! It is with great joy that we introduce to you the Ranjbar family! Lots of meetings, paperwork and emails have been going on behind the scenes to prepare for the approval of the Ranjbar's application and we give thanks to God that their application has been approved! Shafiq, Frozan and their two daughters, Dayana and baby Dilaro, who was just born in May, are very thankful that Spruce Grove Alliance Church has chosen them to be sponsored.

Both Shafiq and Frozan were born in Iran, lived in Afghanistan and due to war and religious persecution they fled and are living in Tajikistan. We believe that God has chosen this family for us. The evidence is in the many details that have come together from the C&MA International workers and other missionaries from Edmonton who have been helping the Ranjbar family overseas.



As a team we have been meeting with the elders and different ministry groups within the church to inform the congregation about sponsoring a refugee family. We have been doing different fundraisers to raise money to support the family when they arrive. We were told that the process could take anywhere from 1-3 years but we recently found out that the family could be arriving in just a few months! We are very excited about this, but it also means there is a lot to be done to prepare for their arrival. The three biggest priorities are the financial obligation, finding and furnishing a home and creating teams of volunteers to help with daily tasks.

The refugee sponsorship fund is currently at \$17,719.74 and we need to raise \$40,000.00 to support the family for a year. We would ask that you would prayerfully consider donating to this fund as we support and care for the Ranjbar family as they settle in Spruce Grove.

The refugee team would ask that if you have a home or rental property available for the family to please let us know. We will also be asking for different items to help furnish the home as well as volunteers to help the family on a daily basis, so please prayerfully consider how you can help and donate your time and resources. ## Walking with Jesus Mark 3:13-15



Centered in Jesus Christ, we will Thrive Spiritually, Build Community, and Reach the Lost by loving our community and serving the world.

It is the goal of SGAC to have the **resurrected Jesus** at the centre of all things. Our desire is to see people grow in their spiritual journey. From one who **investigates** the claims of Jesus to one walking with Jesus as a **mature** person of faith.

To help with the journey we have developed this wheel that helps identify key steps along the pathway. The foundation of a Christian life is to first **believe** in the person of Jesus Christ as the only substitute for our sin, then to **repent** or turn form our sins, followed by a public profession of our faith through the waters of **baptism**. Finally we are to be **filled** with the **Holy Spirit** in order to walk out the Christian journey. In order to mature in our faith we long to encourage followers of Jesus to develop rhythms that foster and strengthen a daily personal relationship with Jesus through prayer and scripture reading.

The second leg in the journey is to "Study to show yourself approved" (2 Tim 2:14-16). It is our hope that each person that attends SGAC would have a clear, in-depth, accurate and full understanding of the **Word of God** and seek to apply it in their daily lives.

In addition, as the Bride of Christ walks in the fullness of the Holy Spirit, the **fruit of the Spirit** will be evidenced in our lives. As the fruit of the Spirit is evidenced so too will we operate using the **Spiritual gifts** in order to glorify God, edify the body and reach lost people with the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Finally, we desire to encourage maturing believers to **serve/mentor** others in the church and those seeking truth and salvation. We long to be a people who make a significant impact for the Kingdom. That Jesus would be pleased by our service and sacrifice.

## Where are the funds used?

### **FUNDRAISING:**

With reaching the milestone of the first two million of cash in June, the focus for the next third (\$2 million) from new/renewed 3-year pledges has begun. We again are asking that everyone who calls SGAC their home church to prayerfully consider their ability to participate financially towards development of Phase 1. Pledges ranging from \$100/yr. and up all help to meet our goals and will be required to proceed. Whether you are submitting a pledge for the first time or plan to renew for the next three years, we are asking EVERYONE to submit a new pledge form so that we know your intentions. #### CONSTRUCTION:

Utility upgrades started in the summer. The wet weather has caused some delays, but the work continues to move forward. By mid-August, a new waterline has been installed and servicing the facility, as well as relocation of the gas meter. Storm water installation is well underway and will continue. Other utility upgrades include the sanitary sewer work which is planned for later August; and electricity upgrades and connection will be completed along with Fortis and is anticipated to take place in September. Building construction plans, and communication with the city continues in preparation for construction once district fundraising guidelines are met. The utility upgrade work that has been completed has been a huge success and we are thankful that everyone has been safe and the work has moved ahead in a timely manner despite all of the rain we have experienced. ### **EXPLORE:**

What does it mean to be a follower of Jesus? What's my next step?

### **GOD'S PERSPECTIVE:**

God loves you and created you to know Him personally. He has a wonderful plan for your life. "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have everlasting life." John 3:16

#### **OUR CONDITION:**

People are sinful and separated from God, so we cannot know Him personally or experience His love and plan. "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." Romans 3:23

### **GOD'S RESPONSE:**

Jesus Christ is God's only provision for our sin.

Through Him alone we can know God personally and experience God's love and plan.

But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Romans 5:8

### **OUR RESPONSE:**

We must individually receive Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord; then we can know God personally and experience His love and plan.

#### **BAPTISM**

If you are interested in learning more about Baptism, come to an information session on September 8 or 15 during each service, in the Prayer Room. Contact Pastor Art to sign up at art.quist@sgac.net.

Baptism is a public declaration of one's belief in God and a testimony of God's involvement in a person's life. It is a decision to tell the world that we love Jesus, that we believe He died and rose again for us, and that we want to live our lives for Him.

We at Spruce Grove Alliance Church understand baptism as a personal decision that each believer must make after entering into a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. For that reason, we do not baptize infants or others who have not yet placed their faith and trust in Jesus.

Baptism is not required for salvation. The Bible says, "If you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9). Baptism in itself does nothing without faith. It is simply an outward sign or a public declaration of what God has done in a person's life.

Like all C&MA churches, Spruce Grove Alliance Church practices baptism by full immersion in a public setting. We understand this to be the Biblical pattern, expressing death to self and new life in Jesus Christ (see Romans 6). Under certain circumstances, however, we will consider a different method of baptism.
