

Apologetics is sadly an unfamiliar word for many in the church.
"It must be a very Canadian discipline," I was once told.
Actually, apologetics has nothing to

do with saying sorry. Rather, it is a discipline in which you seek to provide the rational basis for your beliefs. I hope to "whet the intellectual appetite" of the SGAC family as we train together in seeing the whole world through the lens of a Christian worldview.

Alpha is a series of sessions exploring the Christian faith.

Each talk looks at a different question around faith and is designed to create conversation. Each talk is around thirty minutes long and given as a live talk or played as a video. Come explore the big issues around faith and unpack the basics of Christianity, addressing questions from Who is Jesus? And How can we have faith? To Why and how do I pray? and How does God guide us?

One of the most important parts of any Alpha: the chance to share thoughts and ideas on the topic, and discuss in a small group. It's an opportunity to hear from others and contribute your own perspective in an honest, friendly and open environment.

Discipleship Pathway

Walking with Jesus Mark 3:13-15



Centered in Jesus Christ, we will Thrive Spiritually, Build Community, and Reach the Lost by loving our community and serving the world.

It is the goal of SGAC to have the **resurrected Jesus** at the centre of all things. Our desire is to see people grow in their spiritual journey. From one who **investigates** the claims of Jesus to one walking with Jesus as a **mature** person of faith.

To help with the journey we have developed this wheel that helps identify key steps along the pathway. The foundation of a Christian life is to first **believe** in the person of Jesus Christ as the only substitute for our sin, then to **repent** and turn from our sins, followed by a public profession of our faith through the waters of **baptism**. Finally we are to be **filled** with the **Holy Spirit** in order to walk out the Christian journey. In order to mature in our faith we long to encourage followers of Jesus to develop rhythms that foster and strengthen a daily personal relationship with Jesus through prayer and scripture reading.

The second leg in the journey is to "Study to show yourself approved" (2 Tim 2:14-16). It is our hope that each person that attends SGAC would have a clear, in-depth, accurate and full understanding of the **Word of God** and seek to apply it in their daily lives.

In addition, as the Bride of Christ walks in the fullness of the Holy Spirit, the **fruit of the Spirit** will be evidenced in our lives. As the fruit of the Spirit is evidenced so too will we operate using the **Spiritual gifts** in order to glorify God, edify the body and reach lost people with the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Finally, we desire to encourage maturing believers to **serve/mentor** others in the church and those seeking truth and salvation. We long to be a people who make a significant impact for the Kingdom. That Jesus would be pleased by our service and sacrifice.


UNDERSTANDING THE OLD TESTAMENT:

Giving at SGAC

How can I donate at SGAC?

We have five methods of donating to SGAC:

1. ONLINE GIVING

Whether it is a one-time gift or you would like to schedule a recurring donation, you can give online to Spruce Grove Alliance Church using a Visa or MasterCard debit cards or the traditional Visa or MasterCard credit cards.

2. DIRECT PAYMENT FROM A BANK ACCOUNT

Pick up a pre-authorized debit agreement form at the Welcome Centre. You can fill it out and then return it with a voided cheque - just drop it in one of the offering plates or return it to the Welcome Centre in an envelope marked "Confidential: Donations Clerk".

3. ENVELOPES IN THE CHAIR POCKETS

There are envelopes in the chair pockets in the sanctuary that you can use to make an offering at any time. Please print your name and address (and Giving Number if you have one) clearly so we can correctly disburse the funds and issue your tax receipt. If you don't already have a Giving Number, please inquire in the office and we'd be happy to set you up with one.

4. INTERAC

Use Interac at the Welcome Centre to make your donation while at church, then fill out your donation envelope as normal including your name, address, giving number and insert your debit receipt so we can disburse funds as directed.

5. E-TRANSFER

Use E-Transfer to give at SGAC, using **giving@ sgac.net**. Please include your offering envelope number and contact information. The money is deposited directly into the church account and does not require a security question. (This method of giving is not to be used for registrations.)

Where are the funds used?

General Fund: Make a donation to support the Ministry of Spruce Grove Alliance Church. Your donation to SGAC will help support the general ministries of our church in Spruce Grove. This includes ministry staffing, office staffing, facilities, operating costs and other administrative costs.

Canadian Ministries Fund: Make a donation to support Canadian work of The C&MA. Contributions to the Canadian Ministries Fund will go towards church planting in Canada, the C&MA's Ambrose University/College and Seminary and to other Canadian initiatives.

Future Development Phase I Update

THE FUTURE DEVELOPMENT TEAM is grateful to be working on behalf of a congregation that gives sacrificially to realize our shared vision for the future of Spruce Grove Alliance: a church that is positioned and equipped to meet the growing spiritual needs of the communities we serve. Thank you for your continued participation with Phase 1!

CONSTRUCTION - The parking lot lights will be delivered and installed in early 2020, following the installation of the necessary posts and underground wiring (part of our summer and fall work to lay the foundation for phase 1). We look forward to increased safety and enhancing the curb appeal of SGAC.

FUNDRAISING - As of December 12, 2019, we are \$735,000 away from reaching our goal of \$4 million in cash and pledges (2/3rds of the total project cost).

We had hoped to reach the \$4 million goal by the end of December so that construction could begin in early spring. Not reaching this goal means that construction will be delayed as we are not able to secure the final architectural drawings and building permits until we have 2/3 of the full project cost in cash and dedicated pledges.

As well as working to raise the funds required to begin construction, the Future Development Team will continue to seek skilled tradespeople and willing hands to reduce the anticipated final cost of the project. We will also continue to complete work around the church that will ensure we are ready to begin construction, when our fundraising goals are met. This work will be limited to volunteer labour and low cost repairs and preparations, or supporting the building maintenance team to ensure our existing building remains safe and functional.

What does it mean to be a follower of Jesus? What's my next step?

GOD'S PERSPECTIVE:

God loves you and created you to know Him personally. He has a wonderful plan for your life. "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have everlasting life." John 3:16

OUR CONDITION:

People are sinful and separated from God, so we cannot know Him personally or experience His love and plan. "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." Romans 3:23

GOD'S RESPONSE:

Jesus Christ is God's only provision for our sin.

Through Him alone we can know God personally and experience God's love and plan.

But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Romans 5:8

"Jesus answered, 'I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me." John 14:6

OUR RESPONSE:

We must individually receive Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord; then we can know God personally and experience His love and plan.

"Yet to all who received Him, to those who believed in His name, He gave the right to become children of God." John 1:12.

"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith – and not from yourselves, it is the gift of God – not by works, so that no one can boast." Ephesians 2:8-9

BAPTISM

If you are interested in learning more about Baptism, come to an information session on March1 during each service, in the Prayer Room. Contact Pastor Art to sign up at art.quist@sgac.net.

Baptism is a public declaration of one's belief in God and a testimony of God's involvement in a person's life. It is a decision to tell the world that we love Jesus, that we believe He died and rose again for us, and that we want to live our lives for Him.

We at Spruce Grove Alliance Church understand baptism as a personal decision that each believer must make after entering into a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. For that reason, we do not baptize infants or others who have not yet placed their faith and trust in Jesus.

Baptism is not required for salvation. The Bible says, "If you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9). Baptism in itself does nothing without faith. It is simply an outward sign or a public declaration of what God has done in a person's life.

Like all C&MA churches, Spruce Grove Alliance Church practices baptism by full immersion in a public setting. We understand this to be the Biblical pattern, expressing death to self and new life in Jesus Christ (see Romans 6). Under certain circumstances, however, we will consider a different method of baptism.
